YIELD: ABOUT 70 COOKIES

A variation on an old Austrian cookie, these are irresistible when rolled in powdered sugar. You can also shape them into balls.

2 sticks (1 cup) butter, at room temperature

1/2 cup brown sugar

Pinch of salt

1 cup finely chopped pecans, almonds, or walnuts

1 tsp vanilla extract, or 1/2 tsp

vanilla extract and 1/2 tsp

almond extract

2 cups all-purpose flour, sifted

- 1. In a mixer, cream butter and sugar until fluffy. Add salt, nuts, and vanilla extract; mix well. Add flour and mix well; dough should be crumbly.
- 2. Form dough into ball; place on waxed paper. Refrigerate for 1 hour.
- 3. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Remove dough from refrigerator and let it come to room temperature (about 10 minutes). Roll a tablespoon of dough into a snake shape 1 1/2 inches long and I inch thick, and shape into a crescent. Or roll dough into balls. Place on ungreased baking sheets and bake about 15 minutes, or until lightly browned.
- 4. Place confectioners' sugar on a large plate. Roll **cookies** while still warm in sugar. Let cool, then roll again in sugar; shake off excess.
- 5. HOW KIDS CAN HELP Make shapes; roll **cookies** in sugar.
