- \Box Change the viewing access for a calendar layer so that anyone at your school can view it. (7)
- □ Add and remove an editor to your calendar layer. (7)
- Drag and drop objectives/standards on to the calendar. (12)
- □ Open a calendar item and change its title and text. (14)
- Duplicate a calendar item. (15)
- Drag a blank item to the calendar. (13)
- □ Create a blank calendar item without dragging. (13)
- □ Subscribe to a district holiday and PD calendar layer. (8)
- □ View only one calendar layer and hide all of the others. (9)
- □ Reorder your calendar layers. (10)
- □ Print next week's lesson plans grouped by day. (3)
- □ Print only one of your calendar layers. (3)
- $\hfill\square$ Unsubscribe from the district's holiday and PD calendar layer. (11)
